Market Overview

USA

Dow briefly touches record and S&P 500 closes lower as Nvidia pulls down tech sector. The Dow rose 10.45 points or 0.02%. The S&P 500 Index fell 37.78 points or 0.59%, and the Nasdaq fell 314.82 points or 1.46%.

China

The A-share market closed lower. The Shanghai Composite Index fell 0.74 points or 0.02% to close at 3,727. The ChiNext Index fell 4.46 points or 0.17% to close at 2,601, with a total turnover of CNY 2,590 billion.

Hong Kong

The Hang Seng Index fell 53.95 points or 0.21% to close at 25,122. The Hang Seng Tech Index fell 37.15 points or 0.67% to close at 5,542, with a total turnover of HKD 278.2 billion.

Singapore

The Straits Times Index rose 28.81 points or 0.69% to close at 4,216, with a total turnover of \$\$1.66 billion.

The U.S. Census Bureau reported 1.354 million building permits in July, below market expectations of 1.39 million and the lowest level since June 2020.



The China Passenger Car Association announced that sales of new energy commercial vehicles reached 73,000 units in July, a 55% year-on-year increase and a 3% month-on-month decrease.



Statistics Canada announced that the consumer price index rose by 1.7% in July, slowing from 1.9% in the previous month and below the market forecast of 1.9%.



The Census and Statistics Department announced that the unemployment rate for May-July this year was 3.7%, exceeding market expectations for a 3.5% increase.
